


Ergonomic solutions for a healthier you

Whether working in an office or at home, many of us spend the majority of the day at a desk. Sometimes, working for longer periods in a bad or uncomfortable position can cause neck and back injuries as well as other health problems.

An ergonomic workspace is one that is customised to your personal needs, allowing you to work in a comfortable and safe way. Since we are all different shapes and sizes, it is important to have

an ergonomic workspace that is adapted to your body. This not only benefits your health and wellbeing; it also contributes to improved focus and productivity.





Feel good and work better

We want to help you achieve an ergonomic working environment that suits you and promotes good health. This means adjusting the workspace to your needs, adopting an ergonomic position and keeping as mobile as possible. The human body is made to move, so ideally your workspace should give you the choice of sitting, standing and leaning, allowing you to change positions often. And if you feel good at work, you will work better.

Nine steps to good ergonomics in your workspace

1. Ensure an ergonomic chair







An ergonomic office chair provides proper support for the back, neck, and arms, reducing the risk of discomfort and musculoskeletal issues. It promotes good posture, improves blood circulation and allows for greater comfort and productivity throughout the workday.

Always look for an office chair with good lumbar support and a variety of features that can be adjusted to fit your body.

2. Enable switching between sitting leaning and standing

A height-adjustable desk allows you to change position often. Alternating between sitting and standing reduces the risk of injury and increases circulation, as well as productivity.

A sit/stand support enables a position between sitting and standing, and is ideal when you have a height-adjustable desk. It provides freedom of movement, activates and strengthens the core muscles of your body and improves blood circulation.

The top of your work surface should be elbow height and your elbows should be at a 90° angle when sitting or standing at your desk.







3. Improve the acoustic environment







Acoustic screens absorb and reduce sounds such as laughing, ringtones and typing, creating a quieter and more focused environment. They provide privacy, minimise interruptions and contribute to a more peaceful and productive workspace. Curtains, rugs and other textiles also help absorb sound.

4. Position your monitor correctly

Make sure your monitor is not placed too close. With your chair pulled in and arms stretched in front of you, you should not be able to touch the screen. The monitor should be placed directly in front of you, with the top just below eye level. A monitor stand allows you to position your screen at the right level, reducing strain on your neck and promoting better posture.







5. Hide messy cables







Cable management creates a clean and organised workspace, reducing visual clutter and promoting a sense of calm. It gives easier access to devices and prevents tripping hazards. Desktop-mounted solutions add convenience and prevent strains from bending and reaching for outlets under the desk.

6. Combine different types of lighting

Proper lighting reduces eye strain, enhances focus and creates a comfortable and inviting atmosphere. Usually, a combination of different types of lighting is ideal.

General lighting provides a uniform light throughout the room.

Task lighting such as a desk lamp, provides a concentrated beam of light over a limited area.

Mood lighting provides a cosy feeling and softens the contrasts between general and task lighting.

Sunlight is always welcome, but it can cause glare and reflections on your computer screen. Place your desk/ computer so the light comes in from the side. Use blinds or curtains on the windows to filter or block out daylight when you need to.







7. Relieve pressue on knees and feet







A standing mat is ideal for those who stand for long periods at their desks as the high-density foam relieves pressure on the feet, knees and back.

A footrest helps you sit in a good working position at your desk and reduces strain on your legs, back and neck.

8. Ensure ease of maintenance

A dynamic workplace may take many shapes throughout the workday as furniture is moved around for meetings or impromptu collaboration. Office furniture that is lightweight, on wheels, easy to move and park prevents muscle strain and enables seamless teamwork.







9. Invite elements of nature into your workspace





We have known for a long time that nature has a positive effect on us humans. A bike ride in the park, a walk in the woods or taking in the waves on the beach – the connection to nature makes us feel good. What happens if we can reproduce this effect indoors? Biophilic design is a concept that uses interior design to link our indoor environment with nature. Workplaces with natural light, natural ventilation and elements connected to nature have been shown to improve performance, lower stress and increase motivation.

Colour. Tone on tone colours, close to nature's own colours create a feeling of calm and harmony, helping us to relax and focus.

Material. The materials you choose, such as a warm wood veneer or a tactile material that feels soft to the touch is also a way to bring nature indoors. It is inviting, and we feel good taking it in.

Organic shapes and patterns such as those found on leaves, animals, water and sand make us think of the outside world – they feel familiar and help us to relax.

Greenery in the workspace has been shown to have a calming effect, helping to reduce stress and when we think beyond potted plants in the window, there is a lot we can do. For instance, plants can be used to create room dividers or cozy rooms-within-a-room.

Why acoustics matters

Today, many offices are designed with open floor plans that expose us to noise and visual distractions, influencing our ability to focus. Ring sounds, chattering colleagues, fingers typing away on the keyboard, screeching chairs – all these and other sounds amount to the disturbing noise levels we often experience at our workplace.

Fortunately, there are ways to work around this.

Happy and healthy workspaces involve finding the right noise-reducing solutions and possibilities to create privacy. That's where our acoustic products step in, designed with your well-being in mind to enhance your comfort and productivity.









What is room acoustics?

Room acoustics is how sound travels or behaves within a room or any given space. Without elements to absorb sound or prevent sound waves from bouncing back and forth, we perceive the acoustic environment as disharmonious.

Reverberation time is the time it takes for sound to cease, depending on the size of the room and the objects and materials in the room that absorb sound. With simple measures, we can improve room acoustics and reverberation time to create quieter spaces that are more conducive to working and collaborating.



When there is nothing to block or absorb the sound, the sound waves bounce around the room making the acoustic environment disharmonious for everyone in the surroundings.



The less the sound bounces around, the shorter the reverberation time, which leads to better acoustics and speech intelligibility.

5 steps to good acoustics in the workplace

1. Work with sound absorption.



Non-porous materials like glass, MDF or concrete cause sound to reflect, creating echoes while porous materials like curtains, seat covers and rugs absorb sound. Acoustic products like desk screens and floorstanding screens also absorb sound and help to balance the presence of non-porous materials.

2. Block the sound.



Divide the space into separate acoustic zones using various types of barriers to prevent sound from traveling freely in an open landscape or between two workstations. Desk and floor-standing acoustic screens as well as acoustic screens on castors are ideal for this purpose.

3. Place furniture strategically.

Voices, ring tones, footsteps and other sounds can be softened with acoustic screens and room dividers with green plants. Shelves with books can also help. If possible, prevent unwanted noise altogether by placing printers and coffee machines in separate rooms. Ensure chairs on legs are fitted with felt pads and those on castors roll on sound-absorbing material. Drawer dampers also make a big difference.

4. Use textiles.

Curtains, rugs, plants and other porous, soft objects help absorb sound waves. Use curtains with a thick fabric and hang them a bit out from the wall/window. Furniture with soft seats and seat covers add comfort and also absorb noise.

5. Privacy is important.

Room dividers, desk screens and floor-standing screens all help to divide areas and create both visual and acoustic privacy so you can work with less distractions.



Acoustic products help create a balanced sound environment

Our acoustic products have been developed and tested together with acoustic specialists to ensure they meet sound absorbing and sound blocking requirements. Our designers put special focus on enabling fluid office spaces; and applying patterns, colours and materials

inspired by nature. The thick, quilted screens create a warm and harmonious environment while also ensuring privacy between workstations.



The magic starts on the inside. MITTZON acoustic screens are constructed with a low-density fibreboard core surrounded by a thick, wood fibre filling with excellent acoustic performance. The screens are dressed with a thick, durable fabric that is removable/machine washable. The acoustic screen on castors is 50 mm thick and the desk and floor-standing acoustic screens are 80 mm thick, filled with goodness for your ears.

The filling contains 92% renewable and recyclable wood fibre content sourced from harvested trees which are debarked and chopped into small square chips, not much bigger than postage stamps.

The chips are softened with steam and milled to obtain fibres. The fibres are dried and mixed with a bonding fibre, and then melted together into sheets that are cut to size. Left-over trimming is re-used in the production so that there is no waste.



Acoustic screens on lockable castors can be used to separate desks or create a meeting area. Notes can be pinned directly onto the fabric cover.





Meeting spaces in the office

Digital, physical, long, short, formal or informal – every day we meet our colleagues, customers and partners in many different ways and modern workplaces need to provide a variety of environments designed to support efficiency and productivity through our comfort and well-being.







Different zones for different focus needs

When planning the office, consider the different environments and how they are placed in relation to each other. A good idea is to divide the space into different focus needs. For instance, a zone for working totally undisturbed, a zone where you can work focused but also discuss things with nearby colleagues, and zones for collaboration, activity and movement.



Formal meeting rooms need to be supplemented with a variety of flexible meeting spaces for different purposes.



High tables can be placed together and used while sitting or standing, helping to keep the energy up during workshops.



Flexible elements like acoustic screens, frames on wheels, storage units, plants or textiles help create rooms within rooms.

Open or semi-open environments are often conducive to teamwork, project meetings or spontaneous collaboration. They allow departments to interact more freely and contribute to an inclusive workplace culture. It also opens up the possibility to adapt the space after changing needs.

In creative meetings and brainstorming sessions, it is important to be able to move freely in the environment to keep up the momentum and pace. This is also true for spontaneous meetings where the right setting can help strengthen cooperation and problem solving. For longer or more formal meetings, it is a good idea to arrange a closed room for privacy with comfortable seating.



Flexibility in the workspace

Change is part of the everyday reality in any workplace. Whether it be a re-organisation, a change of routines or new hybrid working patterns. To ensure that the workplace serves many types of functional needs over time while also promoting a sense of balance and well-being – the work environment must be able to adapt to the changing needs both in the short-term and in the long-term.







Day-to-day flexibility

Furniture gets moved around in the workplace all the time. Sometimes it is a matter of moving closer to a colleague to go through a presentation, or it could be about adding extra tables or chairs to a meeting room. For day-to-day flexibility, it is good to have furniture with castors that are easy to move to where they are needed, and just as easy to move back, fold and stack when not in use. 
By providing proper support for your lower back, an ergonomic office chair can also help reduce or prevent back pain. This is particularly important for people who spend long hours sitting.

How to choose an ergonomic office chair

If there is one item that deserves special attention when you choose it for your workplace, it is your office chair. Beyond the aesthetics, there are features that can significantly impact your comfort, health and productivity. That is why it is essential to choose a chair that fits your body and work style, and to adjust it properly for maximum benefit. Here are some things to consider.

How many hours do you sit during the day?

The more hours you sit down, the better chair you will need. To make it easier for you to find a chair that suits your needs, we've divided the range into three recommended solutions:

Basic: If you rarely sit down during your work day, you can do well with a simpler chair with basic features such as height adjustability.

Occasional: If you sit down for short periods during the day, you will also need lumbar support, high back rest, automatic or adjustable tilt tension.

Full working day: If you spend most of your working day sitting down, you need an ergonomic chair with good adjustment possibilities.

Does the chair tick these boxes?

Adjustability

Look for a chair with a variety of adjustable features. The more you can adjust the chair to fit your body, the better. Make sure to use all the functions of the chair and adjust it at regular intervals, to avoid a static sitting position.

Lumbar support

Good lumbar support is crucial for preventing back pain. The backrest should support the natural curve of your lower back.

Seat material

The seat and back should have enough padding to be comfortable for long periods of sitting. Breathable materials such as mesh allow air to pass through, and is a good choice if you tend to feel hot. Some chairs are made with a cooling effect material, also suitable for this purpose.

Swivel and mobility

The chair should easily rotate so you can reach different areas of your desk without straining. Castors allow easy movement around your workspace.

Stability

A five-point base reduces the risk of tipping over when leaning or moving in the chair.

Size

The chair should fit your body size. You should be able to sit with your feet flat on the floor, your knees at a 90° angle, and your back against the backrest. There should also be 5-8 cm between the back of your knees and the seat of the chair.






Different types of lighting for your workspace

When furnishing your workspace with light, it is good to know how different types of lamps spread light and how they can be combined to fulfil the various needs in the office. Good workspace lighting includes a combination of task lighting, general lighting and daylight that does not produce glare or reflections on the work surface. It also requires mood lighting to reduce sharp contrasts.

General light

General lighting, often from ceiling lighting provides a uniform light level throughout the entire room. It does not create significant shadows or sharp contrasts between lit and unlit areas. This type of lighting is ideal to create a good overview. Larger spaces often require larger fixtures to spread light. Larger pendant lamps can be a good way to spread an even light while enhancing the style of your interior. If you don't want the ceiling lighting to be the focal point, you can choose more discreet ceiling lamps.



Task light

Task lighting provides a concentrated beam of light over a limited area to enable specific tasks such as working at the desk or computer, or reading documents in a lounge area. Desk lamps and floor lamps with adjustable arms and head for directing light are good choices for flexible and effective task lighting



Mood light

Mood lighting softens the contrasts between general and task light to create a cosy, intimate setting. To create inviting mood lighting, you can place table lamps in windows, shelves and cabinets where they illuminate at a suitable height. Floor lamps can be placed to light up dark corners. With little effort, your workplace becomes more appealing, relaxing and enjoyable to work in.

How to build

SKYDRAG LED lighting strip is easy to install on your own.

- For MITTZON frame with castors, choose the 80 cm wide lighting strip to get sufficient light over the width of the frame. Place one lighting strip on the metal bar above each display shelf and/or container that you want to illuminate. You can easily hide the cable(s) inside the MITTZON frame for a tidy look.
- · Connect each lighting strip to the TRÅDFRI driver (sold separately) and connect the driver to the plug using FÖRNIMMA power supply cord (sold separately). Hide the driver and cables inside the cable box at the bottom of the frame.
- You can easily turn on/off and dim your lighting or control the entire combination at the same time when you pair RODRET wireless dimmer or STYRBAR remote control with TRÅDFRI driver (sold separately).
- It is also possible to connect the lighting (and other smart products in our range, such as speakers or air purifiers), to the DIRIGERA hub (sold separately) which allows you to control them via the IKEA Home smart app on your mobile

Note: You can connect several lighting strips to TRADFRI driver as long as the total wattage does not exceed the driver wattage.





